We currently serve hundreds of young people on a weekly basis in 3 communities across the northern interior of BC. We're a chartered chapter of Youth for Christ Canada with an independent Board of Directors.

The goal of Youth for Christ Canada has been, since the 1940s, to meet the needs of young people socially, spiritually, physically and mentally. Our mission? To see every young person living fully in Christ.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Primary Objective

We are looking for an individual that is able to provide leadership in the vision, planning and implementation of The 92 Youth Centre in Mackenzie. The 92 Youth Centre Director's primary objective is to engage and equip youth to know and follow Jesus by meeting the needs of the youth in the Mackenzie through running relevant programs and inviting others into the journey through partnership. You are building and overseeing a volunteer team while personally engaging in relational evangelism and program design and delivery. This position will provide support for youth, families, schools, and community. The ability to build strong relationships and interpersonal skills are a high priority. Experience in missionary work and/or post secondary education in a related field is preferred.

The Specifics

- Bring your vision and creativity to help use The 92 space to engage young people
- Create and implement programs including structured and unstructured programs for youth roughly between the ages of 10 and 19
- Maintain the calendar of the youth centre, building great relationships with other stakeholders
- Promote the youth centre through media (social media, news, radio, etc.)
- Study the needs of youth in the community, and ensure programs at the youth centre help meet those needs
- Build relationships and walk alongside the youth of Mackenzie
- Network and maintain good relationships with school principals, teachers, and other stakeholders that are in proximity to the youth centre



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- Ensure that the youth centre is well-maintained
 - Fundraise on behalf of the youth centre
 - Work as part of a team on city-wide youth initiatives
 - Network and maintain good working relationships with churches, youth pastors and other youth workers across the community
 - Be involved in the planning and implementation of Mackenzie fundraising events
 - Fully participate in Ministry Partner Development, building and maintaining relationships with prayer and financial partners through regular communication
 - Other duties as required

Qualifications

- Personally committed to Jesus Christ
- Wholeheartedly in agreement with YFC Canada's Statement of Faith & Community Covenant
- Experience in youth missionary work is preferred
- Post secondary education in a related field is preferred
- Willing to participate in YFC Canada's credentialing process
- Able to work evenings and weekends as required
- Able to work with minimal supervision in a non-structured environment
- Must be able to pass a vulnerable sector criminal record check
